

Know your Freight!

- Cargo containing hazardous materials (dangerous goods) for transportation by aircraft must be offered in accordance with the Federal Hazardous Materials regulations (49 CFR parts 71-180.)
- A violation can result in five years' imprisonment and penalties of \$250,000 or more (49 U.S.C. 5124.)
- Hazardous materials (dangerous goods) include explosives, compressed gases, flammable liquids and solids, oxidizers, poisons, corrosives and radioactive materials.

Examples include:

Fireworks, signal flares, ammunition, gunpowder, explosives, pepper spray, mace, spray cans, medical oxygen, CO-2 cartridges, self inflating rafts, propane cylinders, acetylene cylinders, gasoline, paints, lighter refills, matches, bleach, drain cleaners, solvents, fertilizers, swimming pool chemicals, fiberglass repair kits, pesticides, weed killers, rat poisons, bacterial cultures, viral organisms, radioactive medicines, nuclear metals, acids, alkalis, car batteries, lithium batteries, strong magnets, and dry ice.
